1. One for teachers who are working in metropolitan Perth.
2. One for teachers who are working in regional/rural Western Australia.

The scholarship covers the registration fee for the Conference, which includes free on-site parking, morning and afternoon tea, lunch and sundowner food and drinks each day. Winners will also receive a book pack of quality Australian books. The total value of each scholarship is in excess of \$800.

Eligibility criteria

1. Applicant to be in the first five years of teaching career.
2. Applicant to be a Primary School Teacher.
3. Applicant to be endorsed by the Principal or Deputy Principal.

How to apply

To apply, teachers simply complete the application form (see reverse) and send it back before the deadline. A form can also be downloaded from our website. Teachers must tell us in approximately 200 words: **What Children's Literature means to them and why they want to attend the 2017 Celebrate Reading National Conference.**
