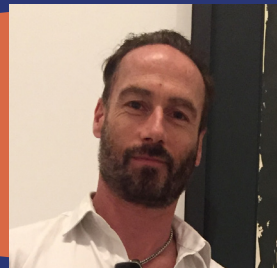
1. How many years have you been teaching?
