Young Writers Online offers a modern and dynamic platform for students (Year 6-12) to learn from award-winning Australian YA authors, develop their writing skills and discover a wide range of genres. This flexible program offers pre-recorded sessions suitable for the classroom or at-home learning in metropolitan, regional or remote WA.

Participants are exposed to strategies used by authors and presented with creative writing exercises via 6 x 30 minute video sessions, tailored to specific year levels. Through blended learning, students will gain tips for generating, organising, and editing their ideas, as well as insights and stories from the authors about their writing life. These practical and fun videos are suitable for ALL students and will be particularly enjoyed by aspiring authors, journalists, editors, publishers, film-makers and content creators.
