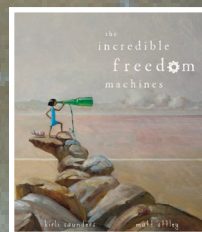

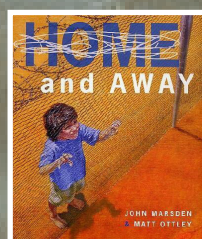


### **The Incredible Freedom Machines**
