'It's time to change the world' is the theme for National Water Week 2019 (21-27 October). We invite you to reflect on this theme and respond in a form of writing of your choice, such as:

- a poem
- a short descriptive piece
- the opening of a novel
- an open letter
- a script/monologue
- a speech
- a blog
- an article
- a fable/fairy tale

A panel of expert judges will assess the originality of your writing and its impact on the reader. 10 finalists will be selected to receive a \$100 book voucher and winners will be given the opportunity to have their work published.

Your writing must be:

- no more than 300 words
- your original work
- reflective of the Water Week theme of 'it's time to change the world', how we use water in our everyday lives and how we can protect it for generations to come.
- approved by a parent/guardian as per the form when you submit.
